Aromatic hydrocarbon solvent for dilution of sealers for resealing and re-activation of existing sealers.

Application Instructions

Reactivating sealers

When used to soften or reactivate old sealer, apply to surface using a solvent resistant broom, work into the surface until sealer reactivates, then while tacky, apply sealer. See relevant sealer TDS for instructions.

Removing tyre marks

Thoroughly clean surface using a general purpose cleaner. Apply a small amount of Sealer Prep to a clean rag or sponge. Use a dabbing motion to re-activate and remove the tyre mark. DO NOT rub or scrub the tyre mark, as this can spread the tyre mark throughout the existing sealer.

Limitations

- Harmful material when incorrectly used.
- Not suitable for water based systems.

TMR10	10 litre drum
TMR20	20 litre pail

Shelf Life

2 years, if kept in unopened container and stored in cool, dry conditions. After this time, the product should be checked for its suitability for use.

Storage

Store in a cool, dry area and keep container sealed.
