Skin Time Retardant Spray for Point Works Gen II

Description

Selleys Point Works Gen II Retardant Spray is specifically formulated to increase the time for *Point Works Gen II* flexible roof pointing to form a skin on the surface. It is available in a 750mL trigger bottle.

Uses

- *Selleys Point Works Gen II Retardant Spray* is recommended for use in hot and windy conditions where skinning of the *Point Works Gen II* may be a problem.

Features/Advantages

- The application of the retardant spray will extend the skinning time of *Point Works Gen II* by approximately 20 minutes (depending on ambient conditions).
- It may be used to retard surface skinning of *Point Works Gen II* in the bucket, or after the pointing has been applied.

Instructions for Use/Application Instructions

The following should only be used as a guide and the installer should apply all Australian Standards, BCA/NZBC requirements, and best practices when pointing roofs with *Point Works Gen II*.

- Spray should be applied before *Point Works Gen II* has skinned over (usually within 10 minutes of opening the bucket or applying the pointing to the roof).
- Use the “spray” setting to apply *Point Works Gen II Retardant Spray* to the surface of before *Point Works Gen II* before it has skinned over.
- Do not use a “stream” setting as the jet may wash out the pointing
- Use as required in order to slow down skinning in the bucket, or as a tooling aid.
- Spray from a distance of approximately 20 centimetres to ensure an even coverage.

- *Point Works Gen II Retardant Spray* should be used as supplied. Do not dilute with water.
- Do not use *Point Works Gen II Retardant Spray* if rain is likely.

Storage

Store unopened bottles below 30°C in a cool dry place away from direct sunlight. Unopened bottles can be stored for 24 months from the date of manufacture.

No special personal protective equipment required. Wash hands after use. Rubber gloves are recommended if handling often.
